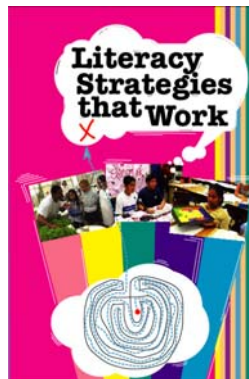


Literacy Strategies that Work
